

PROGRAM BOXES

Are you looking for ways to enrich your troop's Girl Scout experience?

Program boxes and resources are now available to help leaders provide program for their troop. They may be reserved for your troop by calling or writing the Program/Service Center in Fayetteville. Please indicate: leader name and address (mailing address if we are to mail the box to you), troop number, the box you would like to use and the date (list two choices) you would like to have the box. Program boxes may be signed out for up to 4 weeks. The F.A.C.T program box may be signed out for 8 weeks. Leaders are responsible for returning boxes, either by providing postage for return by mail or by dropping the material off at the Program/Service Center in Fayetteville. Try-Its and badges must be purchased by the leader.

Tennis Anyone? *NEW*****

For: Brownie and Junior Girl Scout Troops Fee: cost of patch Deposit Fee: \$20.00

Play tennis? Want to learn how to play tennis? This program box will teach girls about the basic strokes, learning how to keep score, what food is fuel when playing sports and much more. The girls will earn the Tennis Anyone? NOARK patch. Included in the box are tennis racquets, tennis balls and instructions for the leader. Deposit fee will be returned to the troop if the program box is returned in the same condition as when checked out.

Zink the Zebra

For: Brownie Girl Scout Troops Fee: \$5.00 per girl

This is an exciting program that teaches understanding, respect, compassion and acceptance of ourselves and others. Each girl will receive a Zink the Zebra beanie animal and a Zink the Zebra patch. Troops will receive the beautiful Zink the Zebra book to keep or donate to a local organization *as long as the supply lasts*.

Safety Sense Try-it

For: Brownie Girl Scout Troops Fee: \$5.00 usage fee

This program box will help the girls "Be Prepared" by making a safety center with important information; learn about fire, street and playground safety, and to learn about first aid. Girls will earn the Safety Sense Try-it.

F.A.C.T. – First Aid for Children Today - American Red Cross

For: Brownie Girl Scout Troops Fee: \$1.75 per girl

This is a program to enable the girls to help themselves and others be aware of dangers, prevent injuries and respond when injuries do happen. They learn what first aid program measures they can take to help the environment as well. Contents include a leader's guide, seven full-color posters, and copies of the F.A.C.T. Fun Book (cost \$1.75 per girl). All supplies (except a few basic supplies – crayons, scissors, etc.) and all copies of the lesson stories for the girls and letters to the parents will be supplied for this program.

Listening to the Past Try-it

For: Brownie Girl Scout Troops Fee: \$5.00 usage fee

This program box will help the girls learn about how people used to live and what children did a long time ago. Supplies include books about the past, stories about women in the past to use in skits, and 2 or 3 games of the past (with instructions about other games to play). NOTE: This will complete 3 (#4,5,6) out of 4 required activities for the try-it.

Drawing and Painting Junior Badge

For: Junior Girl Scout Troops Fee: \$1.00 per girl

Complete this badge with the supplies in this program box. Supplies include paints, pastels, chalk, sponges, paper, articles on women artists, and books about art to help the leader present this badge to the girls.

3-D Art Junior Badge

For: Junior Girl Scout Troops Fee: \$1.00 per girl

Wire, wood pieces, and modeling material are just a few of the supplies included in this box. The girls will have fun learning about three-dimensional art through sculpture, origami, and mobiles while earning this Junior badge.
