

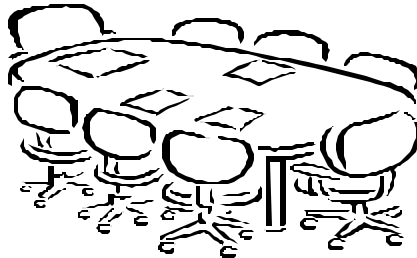
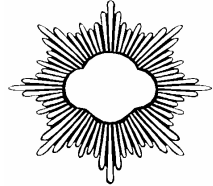
# 2007-2008 OGCS Members Workshop
